

**MINUTES
BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING
FEBRUARY 17, 2016**

The Downingtown Borough Council met in regular session on February 17, 2016 at the Municipal Government Center, 4 W. Lancaster Ave., Downingtown, PA. Members present: President Gazzo, Vice President Rakoff, Councilors Dague, McGlone, Thomas and Feldman. Also attending were Mayor Maxwell and members of Borough staff.

President Gazzo called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Approval of Borough Council Minutes (February 3, 2016) – Councilor Thomas made a motion to approve the Council minutes of February 3, 2016, Councilor Dague seconded; motion carried 5-0. (Councilor Feldman abstained, she did not attend the meeting.)

Crowded Castle, Inc. Conditional Use Hearing Decision & Order – Councilor Dague made a motion to approve the Crowded Castle, Inc. conditional use application decision and order, Vice President Rakoff seconded; motion carried unanimously.

Resolution 2016-04 Authorization to Execute Supplemental General Reimbursement Agreement for Federal Aid Projects (Chestnut Street Bridge) – Councilor Dague made a motion to adopt Resolution 2016-04, Vice President Rakoff seconded; motion carried unanimously.

Mayor & Council Updates

President Gazzo announced the February 24th Borough Council meeting is canceled, next meeting will be held on March 2, 2016.

Councilor Dague reported plans are moving ahead for the Historic Commission's World War II event scheduled during April. Tickets for the Log House Candlelight Dinner will be sold and proceeds will benefit the Cannon Monument project.

Councilor McGlone reported she is continuing research on the Borough newsletter and the pricing looks equitable, she will provide additional information next meeting.

Councilor Feldman reported she heard the Supreme Court will hear the appeals regarding Kardon Park from both parties (Borough/Developer also Kim Manufacturing/Friends of Kardon Park), no date has been set.

President Gazzo pleaded with Council members to notify him or Mr. Sullins, as a common courtesy, if they are not able to attend a meeting.
