

**MINUTES
BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING
DECEMBER 19, 2018**

The Downingtown Borough Council met in regular session December 19, 2018 at the Municipal Government Center, 4 W. Lancaster Ave., Downingtown, PA. Members present: President Gazzo, Vice President Rakoff, Councilors Dague, McGlone and Thomas. Also attending were Solicitor O'Keefe and members of Borough staff. Mayor Maxwell and Councilor Feldman did not attend.

Approval of Borough Council Minutes (December 5, 2018) – Councilor Dague made a motion to approve the Borough Council minutes of December 5, 2018, Councilor McGlone seconded; motion carried 4-0 (Councilor Thomas abstained).

Resolution 2018-15 Land Development Plan Approval D.A.S.D./S.T.E.M. Academy – Mr. Dale Lauver, Director of Facilities, D.A.S.D., reviewed the proposed building and parking renovations and answered questions from Borough Council. After discussion, Councilor Dague made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-15 with the proposed changes, Vice President Rakoff seconded; motion carried unanimously.

Milltown Beer Garden Event (January 19, 2019) – Chief Holland stated there were problems with their prior events and expectations. After discussion, Councilor Thomas made a motion to approve the event contingent upon PLCB approval and meeting requirements stipulated by the Police Department and Public Works, Councilor Dague seconded; motion carried unanimously.


