

Electronics Disposal

Due to the Pennsylvania Covered Device Recycling Act which addresses the recycling and disposal of certain electronic devices in Pennsylvania, the hauler can no longer accept E-waste as a bulk/trash item. E-Waste is: Desktop/laptop computers, monitors, printers, copiers, televisions (both with cathode ray tube and non-CRT), answering machines, camcorders, cell phones, laptop docking stations, electric typewriters, fax/copy machines, microwaves, radios, pagers, remote controls, gaming consoles, stereo/tape/CD players, telephones & equipment, toner/ink cartridges, and VCR/DVD players. These items must be taken to an electronics collection point or drop-off location.
